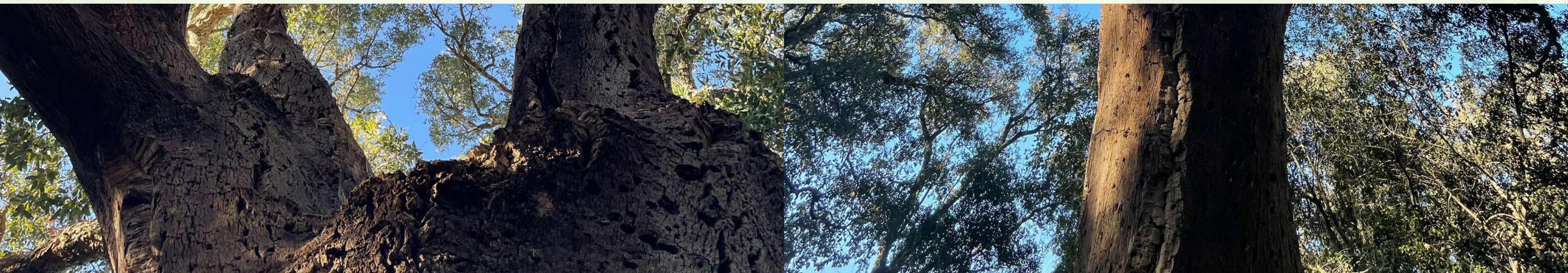

THE MALE CORK, AND IT CAN BE REMOVED FROM THE TRUNK
AFTER 15-20 YEARS
WHILE THE FEMALE CORK CAN BE REMOVED AFTER 9 YEARS AND
IT HAS A HIGHER QUALITY**
